DocuWare 5 has been tested on the basis of FDA Rule 21 CFR Part 11 and complies with the regulations of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. This means the Document Management System can be used by companies in the pharmaceutical and food industry inspected by the FDA. DocuWare CONNECT to SAP has undergone the standard SAP test and been certified by SAP AG. The Microsoft .NET-based interface is augmented by SAP NetWeaver solutions with features for archiving documents and data via the SAP ArchiveLink interface. The functionalities of three components were certified: SAP HTTP Server, Barcode BAPI and OLE Frontend.



DocuWare's quality management system meets the EN ISO 9001:2008 international standard. DocuWare 5 has been successfully tested on Microsoft platforms including Windows 2003 Server, Windows XP Client and SQL Server 2005, thereby passing the Windows platform test. The tests were carried out independently by VeriTest, a test service of Lionbridge Technologies, Inc.



Network Appliance has certified the integration of DocuWare 5 with its NetApp SnapLock storage technology. DocuWare 5 can be used with NetApp SnapLock to store business-critical data in a tamper-proof, long-term format. The solution combines the advantages of the Document Management System with the high access speed of a hard disk, backed up by the security of a WORM medium.



DocuWare 5 has undergone extensive testing by Hewlett-Packard and has been certified for HP File System Extender (FSE) 3.4. The HP FSE software is a file system archiving product for storing and managing large volumes of data at low cost. Standardized interfaces ensure smooth integration with DocuWare.



EMC Centra storage systems integrate seamlessly in DocuWare 5. The certificate confirms that even large volumes of electronic data can be stored in Centra storage systems direct from DocuWare in a secure, tamper-proof format for long-term digital archiving.



DocuWare 5 supports Qualified Electronic Signatures, thereby meeting EU regulations. As documented in the specifications supplied by DocuWare AG, the DocuWare 5 Document Management System contains integrated signature components that meet all required security measures. Germany's Signature Law outlines the legal framework for the creation and use of electronic signatures as well as the regulation of signature and certification services. Germany's Federal Network Agency (Bundesnetzagentur) has published the Manufacturer's Declaration of DocuWare AG in the Official Journal No. 4/2008.



DocuWare 5 meets all requirements concerning the tamper-proof long-term archiving and safekeeping of business data under the regulations of the German Commercial Code (Handelsgesetzbuch, HGB) and the German tax code (Abgabenordnung, AO). The software also complies with the principles of correct computer-assisted accounting systems, as well as the principles surrounding the access to and audit ability of digital data. A summary of these test results is included in the Ernst & Young Certification Report.



DocuWare 5 fulfills all of the requirements set forth by Spain's Tax Authority for archiving paper-based documents. This includes Regulation EHA/932/2007 Article 7 and the resolution from October 24, 2007.
